#### **GOALS**

# 1. Engage in Meaningful Advocacy

We will create innovative ways to advocate for diverse students needs.

By 2023, we hope to achieve this goal by...

- a. Keeping the best interests of students at the forefront of our advocacy efforts.
- b. Improving student experience both within and outside the classroom through academic advocacy.
- c. Creating advocacy campaigns that are relevant and tackle issues that are important to students.

## 2. Enhance Student Representation

#### **GOALS**

## 1. Social Sustainability

We will be leaders of equity, diversity, and inclusion at all levels, making UNB a kinder, healthier, and more welcoming place for all.

By 2023, we hope to achieve this goal by...

- a. Assisting students in developing informed opinions and making choices that promote a healthy and fulfilling life of growth.
- b. Ensuring our campaigns, events, and services meet the diverse needs of our student body and creating spaces where students feel safe and welcomed.
- c. Recognizing that the UNB student experience takes place on the stolen, unsurrendered, and unceded traditional lands of Wolastoqiyik. We will actively engage with Indigenous students to create awareness and cultural competency within our institution.

#### 2. Environmental Sustainability

We have a duty to protect the land that UNB students live, learn, work, and play on. We will create awareness around Green living, advocate for a greener university community, and invest in initiatives that help heal our Planet.

By 2023, we hope to achieve this goal by...

- a. Expanding the UNBSU Garden through full-time summer staff, annual applications to the Environmental Trust Fund, awareness campaigns, and physical expansion.
- b. Making every UNBSU event Green Certified and promoting Green Certification to our constituents.
- c. Tackling student food insecurity by creating and sustaining a UNBSU Food Banks program partnership with Greener Village Food Banks, maintaining the Fresh Food Bags program, and advocating for the university to offer more local food and reduce food waste.
- d. Creating sustainability awareness campaigns, promoting the Student Sustainability Fund, and pushing for UNB to divest from fossil fuels.

#### 3. Financial Sustainability

We will ensure our students are able to attend post secondary education without the burden of elevated student debt. We will maintain our budget and continue to offer high-quality events, services, and advocacy in the years to come.

- a. Developing a sustainable financial model for UNBSU operations.
- b. Ensuring fair compensation for all employees of the Student Union.
- c. Pushing for equal financial opportunity to attend post secondary education.
- d. Improving the availability and attainability of quality housing with improved living conditions.





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
